



**The Family Engagement Plan at Parkway Village places a strong emphasis on the educational process. We have a written parent involvement policy/plan which includes all the following: developed jointly with parents, agreed on with parents, distributed to parents and is being implemented.**

To ensure that our parents participate in the development and implementation of the school's program, Parkway Village will ensure the following:

1. Parents are notified of the policy in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practicable in a language the parents can understand.
2. The school's parent involvement plan is made available to the local community. The plan is updated periodically to meet the changing needs of parents and the school.
3. The school has convened an annual parent meeting to inform parents about the school's parent involvement programs and rights of parents to be involved.
4. The school offers a flexible number of meetings- morning, afternoon and evening.
5. Parents, or an adequate representation of parents, are involved in an organized, ongoing and timely way in planning, review and improvement of the school parent involvement policy and the school wide program plan.
6. Provide parents with timely information about school programs under ESSA.
7. The school provides parents a description and explanation of the curriculum the school uses, forms of academic assessments used to measure student progress, and proficiency levels students are expected to meet.
8. If requested by parents, the school provides opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their children and respond to such suggestions as soon as practically possible.
9. A process is in place for parents to submit comments on the school wide program (TSIPP) if it is not satisfactory to the parents when the school makes the plan available to the District.
10. Assistance is provided to parents in understanding topics such as the State's academic content standards, State student Academic achievement standards, State and local academic assessments, how to monitor a child's progress and how to work with educators to improve student achievement.
11. In order to foster parent involvement and help parents work with their children to improve student achievement, materials and training such as literacy training and the use of technology are provided.
12. With the assistance of parents, school staff members are educated regarding the value and contributions of parents and in working with parents-how to reach out to, communicate with and work as equal partners, implement and coordinate parent programs and build ties between parents and the school.
13. To the extent feasible and appropriate, parent involvement activities are coordinated and integrated with parent involvement activities under other programs such as Head Start and other preschool programs.
14. The school ensures that information related to school and parent programs, meetings and other activities is sent to parents in a format and to the extent practicable, in a language parents can understand.
15. If requested, the school provides other reasonable support for parent involvement activities.
