Notes for Clarification 5.3 (ECERS-3 page 22) **“Individualized”** children’s’ artwork means that each child had carried out the work in his or her way. So individualized products will look quite different from one another. Even if a general subject is introduced by the staff and discussed with the children (e.g., things we see or like to do in Spring), as long as each child is encouraged to interpret and create his or her idea in his or her way, then, the resulting products will be unique and individualized.
