Four-Year Planning

The Four-Year Focused Plan of Study helps 9th-12th grade students plan for and monitor their progress towards course graduation requirements for four years. Students begin creating their course of study during the spring semester of their 8th grade year. The initial plan will help students identify core courses, major/minor electives and early post-secondary options that are available in high school. School Counselors work with students, parents/ guardians, and teachers to support development of a purposeful plan of study.
