3. Schedule annual meetings to explain the components and requirements of Title I.
4. Involved parents in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, in the planning, review, and improvement of a Parent-School Compact and a Family Engagement Plan showing how parents, schools, and students share responsibilities.
5. Offer workshops for parents in parenting skills, technology and literacy.
6. Provide regular meetings at flexible times for parents to participate in decisions relating to their child's education.
7. Provide parents with copies of grade-level curriculum, as provided by the District (brochures).
